

Terms and Conditions of Entry Golden Circle – LOL KCA’s Sponsor Competition

1. Information on how to enter form part of these Conditions of Entry for the Nickelodeon & Golden Circle LOL Competition.
2. There is one method of entry for this competition.

Online

To enter, entrants must log onto the Nickelodeon website (www.nickelodeon.com.au/lol) and either; 1) Register their Nick Name and Password by providing the following information; First name, Last name, Address, State, Postcode, Date of birth, whether they are a girl or a boy, the school they attend, contact number, and their email address, and some other optional information; or 2) If the entrant has previously registered their details they are only required to enter their Nick Name and Password in order to enter the competition.
